The Original Hobo Band, Inc. is sponsoring its 15th Annual Summer Youth Band Program. The program is intended for students having a minimum of one year playing experience to students having completed eighth grade or five years playing experience. Certified music educators will be directing and instructing the students. In addition, Hobo Band members have volunteered to help. Furthermore, we encourage music teachers to play and/or assist as needed. This program offers participating students the opportunity to continue to play and learn through the summer months, meet their counterparts from neighboring school districts and towns, and make new friends.

PLEASE READ THE GROUP DESCRIPTIONS BELOW TO CHOOSE THE MOST APPROPRIATE GROUP FOR YOUR CHILD. Due to enrollment, the program offers three separate groups—divided according to ability—to provide for the most rewarding ensemble experience. Also, for the most rewarding experience for your child and the other students involved, we encourage that your child attend as many weekly rehearsals as possible.

GROUP ¹

- This group is intended for students who started playing a band instrument this current school year and have at least a five note range and ability to play whole, dotted half, half, quarter and eighth note patterns.
- This group meets on Tuesday evenings from 6:30 PM to 7:30 PM.
- Rehearsal Dates: June 9, 16, 23, 30, July 7, 14, 21, 28 *All rehearsals held at 690 Lambs Road.
- Final Rehearsal & Pizza Party is Monday, August 3 from 6:30 PM to 7:30 PM.
- ♪ Public Concert is Tuesday, August 4, 2009 at 7:00 PM in Historic Sunset Auditorium in Pitman.

GROUP ¹

- This group is intended for students that have played a band instrument for two or three school years and have the ability to play the requirements listed for Group 1 with additional skills to play dotted note and sixteenth note rhythms and concert B-flat, A-flat, and E-flat scales.
- ${\it \Gamma}$ This group meets on Tuesday evenings from 8:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

GROUP 5

This group is intended for more advanced students that have played a band instrument for four or more school years and are fluent with various rhythmic notation and have experience with numerous concert scales, including chromatic.


